

PRESSURE TREATED VS. CEDAR



Pressure Treated

Durability: Pressure treated lumber is infused with preservatives under high pressure, making it highly resistant to decay, rot, and insect infestation.

Longevity: This type of lumber has an extended lifespan compared to untreated wood, making it suitable for outdoor applications like fencing.

Low Maintenance: Requires minimal upkeep compared to untreated wood. Routine inspections and occasional staining or sealing can help maintain its appearance and structural integrity.

Appearance: Pressure treated lumber can be purchased pre-stained, removing the need to stain once the fence in construction. Raw pressure treated wood has a yellow/green color to it and it is recommended to be stained.

Resistance to moisture: Pressure treated wood's resistance to moisture makes it ideal for outdoor structures like fences, which are constantly exposed to weather elements.

Cost: In addition to its durability and longevity, pressure treated lumber's lower upfront cost compared to alternative materials like cedar or composite makes it a budget-friendly option for homeowners looking to build a high-quality fence without breaking the bank.



Cedar offers a more sustainable alternative to pressure-treated lumber. Unlike pressure-treated wood, which relies on chemical treatments to resist decay and pests, cedar's natural properties provide similar protection without the need for harmful additives. By opting for cedar, you not only reduce reliance on chemicals but also support a more eco-friendly material choice with minimal environmental footprint.

Cedar contains natural oils and chemicals that act as preservatives, offering inherent resistance to decay, rot, and insect damage, without the need for chemical treatment.

Low-Maintenance: Cedar requires minimal upkeep compared to other types of wood. Periodic sealing or staining can help maintain its natural color and protect it from weathering.

Environmentally Safe: Cedar is free from harmful chemicals, making it safe for humans, pets, and surrounding vegetation, aligning with eco-friendly landscaping practices.

Will last for decades with proper maintence and care.


Maintenance

Scalloped Top


A good option for picket fence when trying to soften the fences overall feel. These fences work well to complement the landscaping of your yard.

Durability


Often constructed with pressure treated materials, and less susceptible to rot.




Maintenance
